NATURE OF COURSE CONTENT:

Private instruction in an applied instrument (guitar). One 30-minute lesson will be scheduled each week. This course is open to all non-music majors.

GOALS AND OUTCOMES:

As a result of this course the student should be able to: 1. Perform three works in a style of your choice; 2. Demonstrate technical proficiency on the applied instrument; 3. Improvise chordal accompaniment from a lead sheet.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

The student will be required to learn a minimum of three works. *At the discretion of the instructor, fewer or more works may be assigned.* In addition, the student may be required to learn various technical studies. The materials to be covered will be geared to the needs of the individual student.

The student is responsible for: 1. One-half hour of practice per day. 2. Demonstration of assigned work at each lesson.

METHOD OF EVALUATION:

The final grade will be based upon an assessment of the improvement of performance of assigned materials from lesson to lesson.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED:

Works and technical studies will be assigned based upon the proficiency level of the individual student.
